Water	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Place posters in all bathrooms to advise guests against water waste. ✓ Provide showers in bathrooms as it uses a third of the water compared to a bath. ✓ Operate linen and towel change policy that reduces laundry requirement, which conserves water and energy. ✓ Use wipeable covers on tablecloths in the Dining room, to reduce laundry requirement, which conserves water and energy. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Only boil and use the amount of water in the kettle that you need. ✓ Turn the tap off when you are brushing your teeth or shaving rather than leaving it running. ✓ Use towels as needed and not for the sake of using them. ✓ Avoid staining or soiling bed linen, towels, carpet and other materials which requiring extra laundry services
Recycling	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Waste we do produce are recycled, wherever possible, to reduce pollution. ✓ Use dedicated bins for plastic, glass, tins, paper, green and domestic waste. ✓ Reduce paper consumption and increase electronic and cloud based platforms for business operations. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Put plastic or glass bottles, food and drink cans, newspaper, and cardboard in labelled recycling room bins, so that Housekeeping can recycle these.
